**WELFARE OF FARMED ANIMALS (ENGLAND) REGULATIONS 2007
VETERINARY MEDICINE REGULATIONS 2006**

Thank you for showing me around the farm on Monday 10th December. As I explained at the time, the visit was a randomly-selected welfare inspection, carried out as part of an annual EU survey. It was a most interesting visit and I was very impressed by the welfare standards at both of the sites.

The farm complies fully with the welfare legislation in all but two points. These are medicines records and mortality records. I enclose a summary of the Medicines Regulations as they apply to livestock farms. You will see that for all medicines (and this includes wormers, vaccines etc) you should be recording details of the medicine used, date of use and withdrawal period. You should also keep a record of the medicines purchased. For mortality records you should keep a note in a diary of the number of birds found dead each day. Would you ensure that the appropriate records are kept in the future.

I enclose a leaflet on Poultry Litter Management, which may be interest. If I can be of assistance regarding the poultry, please do not hesitate to contact me.
